### PATCHWORK

The patchwork activity has been running for 2 years now. Michèle

Glock, from France, is the patchwork teacher.

There are 9 physically handicapped people from Soho-ku in the workshop meeting every Tuesday afternoon. These new skills can later be used to start a small business and thereby help the disabled participants to become more independent and self-sufficient.

Currently, the patchwork workshop also allows its participants to retrieve a regular salary from selling its own production at charity sales and local showrooms.
